



CRITERIA FOR PSYCHOLOGICAL EVALUATIONS

- Testing must be performed by a licensed psychologist and must have been completed within the last year.
- Psychological Testing performed by the **school system** in the last year may substitute for parts of the criteria below **if supplemented** by clinical interviews and/or additional testing by a **licensed** psychologist in the last six months.
- Chestnut Mountain Ranch may require additional assessment as determined by a clinical psychologist consulting for Chestnut Mountain Ranch, Inc.
- Psychological evaluations must cover the following areas using appropriate tests as listed below:

1. INTELLIGENCE *(one of the following & most recent version)*

- Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children (WISC)
- Sanford-Binet Intelligence Scale

2. ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT *(one of the following & most recent version)*

- Woodcock Johnson Psychoeducational Battery- Revised- Achievement Tests
- Wechsler Individual Achievement Test (WIAT)
- Kaufman Test of Educational Achievement (K-TEA)
- Peabody Individual Achievement Test- Revised (PIAT)
- Wide Range Achievement Test- (WRAT)

3. VISUAL MOTOR INTEGRATION *(one of the following)*

- Bender Gestalt
- Beery Test of Visual Motor Integration
- Rey-Osternieth Complex Figure Test

4. MEMORY TESTING *(if determined appropriate by the psychologist)*

5. ATTENTION AND CONCENTRATION *(if determined appropriate by the psychologist, one of the following)*

- Test of Variables of Attention (TOVA)
- Conners' Continuous Performance Test (CCPT)
- Gordon Diagnostic System
- Cancellation Tests
- Other tests as determined by psychologist

6. NEUROPSYCHOLOGICAL TESTING *(if determined appropriate by the psychologist)*

7. PERSONALITY/SOCIAL/EMOTIONAL *(as determined by the psychologist & most recent version)*

- Parent Questionnaires (from all parent figures)
- Teacher Questionnaires (from all teachers)
- Rorschach
- TAT
- MMPI-A
- Personality Inventory for Children
- Children's Depression Inventory
- Children's Manifest Anxiety Scale
- Other tests as determined by the psychologist

8. DSM-IV TR DIAGNOSIS MUST BE INCLUDED

9. CLINICAL INTERVIEW *(Including the following information)*

Family history, Developmental History, Placement and/or Treatment History
